Statement on the Supreme Court decision on Case of Dubin Orthopedic Center PSC vs. Commonwealth of Kentucky, Board of Physical Therapy

The Kentucky Supreme Court on April 23, 2009, issued an opinion that weakened the state law designed to prohibit use of the term “physical therapy” to refer to services that are not provided by or under the supervision of a licensed physical therapist. The law, part of the physical therapy practice act, was intended to protect patients and third-party payors from being misled into believing that services were provided by a physical therapist when in truth they were not. The case involved the use of CPT codes 97001 (“Physical therapy evaluation”) and 97002 (“Physical therapy re-evaluation”) by a medical practice that did not employ any physical therapist and did employ an athletic trainer – who at certain times was not even licensed. The state law contains an exemption making the prohibition against misuse of “physical therapy” inapplicable to any licensed practitioner who is “engaging in the practice for which such person is duly licensed.” Unfortunately, the Supreme Court interpreted this clause to exempt the medical doctor in question when billing for his or her services.

The Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy and APTA respectfully, but emphatically, disagrees with the Court’s interpretation, which treats the mere act of billing as being part of the “practice of medicine.” The Court evidently relied to some extent on a passage in the introduction to the 2006 edition of the Current Procedural Terminology, which says, “Any procedure or service in any section of this book may be used to designate the services rendered by any qualified physician or other qualified health care provider.” Although the Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy and APTA in general agrees that CPT codes properly may be used by any qualified health care provider, the Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy and APTA does not believe that a code explicitly referring to “physical therapy” should be used to describe a non-physical therapist’s services.

The term protection law at the heart of the Dubin case is not about prohibiting physicians from doing what they are qualified to do. Rather, it is about protecting the public from being misled.

In a case involving a statute almost identical to the Kentucky statute, the Pennsylvania Supreme Court enforced the law as written against licensed professionals who were not physical therapists, saying, “No longer is physical therapy understood to be merely a generic term for physical treatment.” Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs v. State Board of Physical Therapy, 556 Pa. 268, 274, 728 A.2d 340, 343 (Pa. 1999). The Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy and APTA are disappointed that the Kentucky Supreme Court effectively overrode the determination of the Kentucky legislature that “physical therapy” is not just a generic term.

The Kentucky Board of Physical Therapy on May 13, 2009 filed a petition for rehearing with the Kentucky Supreme Court. A decision on this request is pending.

Continued Competency

What we learned and what you should know!

Renewal is over once again! What we have learned from the many telephone calls and the audit is many credential holders do not follow 201 KAR 22:045.

- Category 1 courses must be three (3) or more contact hours.
- The “independently verifiable” documentation/certificates must clearly show the date of the course, title of course, your name, number of contact hours, and approval number.
- All Category 1 courses, seminars, workshops, symposia or home study course shall be approved courses.
- Jurisprudence Examination (JE), also known as the Open-book tutorial, is an examination on Kentucky laws and regulations. **Everyone** is required to complete this examination **each** renewal period.

Requirements and tips for the current biennium ending 3/31/2011:

- Contact hours shall be earned April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2011.
- Home study courses, workshops, seminars or symposia shall be a minimum of three (3) contact hours.
- **All** credential holders shall complete the new Jurisprudence Examination (JE) by March 31, 2011. Print and retain your certificate for your records.
- The **NEW** Jurisprudence Examination (JE) will be available at <http://pt.ky.gov> on or after August 1, 2009.
- Physical Therapists are required to obtain 30 contact hours.
- Physical Therapist Assistants are required to obtain 20 contact hours.
- **New graduates** (2009 and 2010) must complete the Jurisprudence Exam only, as their education meets the criteria for competency credit.
- Keep all certificates and documentation for three years from the end of the biennium.

How many hours are required for each category as stated in 201 KAR 22:045?

Category 1:

- Physical Therapists must earn **at least 18** contact hours from Category 1.
- Physical Therapists Assistants must earn **at least 10** contact hours from Category 1.
- But all of your contact hours (except JE) **may** be obtained from Category 1. You are not required to have any contact hours in Category 2.

Category 2

- **No more than 10** contact hours may be earned from Category 2 for Physical Therapists.
- **No more than 8** contact hours may be earned from Category 2 for Physical Therapist Assistants.

Approved courses are posted at <http://pt.ky.gov> . It takes 4-6 weeks to get a course approved, and the application and documentation must be submitted to KPTA within 30 days of taking the course. It is your job to visit the website regularly for new information and updates on licensing, continued competency and board issues.

IMPORTANT REGULATION CHANGE

201 KAR 22:053 Section 5

(4) Discharge summary, which shall be a written or typed, signed, and dated statement.

- (a) A physical therapist assistant may write the discharge summary, which shall be countersigned by the responsible physical therapist.
- (b) The discharge summary shall include:
 1. The date of discharge;
 2. The reason for discharge;
 3. The physical therapy status upon discharge; and
 4. A discharge plan, which shall include recommendations the physical therapist has regarding the need for continuing physical therapy.
 5. **A discharge summary shall be written within thirty (30) days of the termination of the current plan of care if a subsequent plan of care has not been established;**

ADDICTION by Brian Fingerson, RPh

It is estimated that 7.8% of the population in the United States has diabetes. There is a substantial amount of education on this disease, and its symptoms and complications in our professional schools. It is a chronic disease that is treatable but has no cure. Yet a chronic, progressive, and fatal disease that affects an estimated 10% of our population, **addiction**, receives little attention in our professional schooling. The estimated number of people afflicted who are health care professionals is 12-16%. This number doesn't include those who are directly or indirectly affected (note the afflicted – those with the disease - and the affected).

If you would like to learn more about addiction, you have several options. A brilliant, clinical text (in my opinion) is the book, **Alcoholics Anonymous**. While it was written in 1938 and published in 1939, it provides an insightful description of this disease, its symptoms, and an option for treatment.

You may look to the annual CAPTASA conference www.CAPTASA.org held in Lexington, KY in January. The University of Utah School on Alcoholism and Other Drug Dependencies is held in Salt Lake City, Utah in June each year. The website www.USAPRN.org provides a comprehensive listing of conferences, meetings, articles, and other sources of information on addiction.
